### Robbery

1. Wed 20/01/2010 1640 to 1647hrs. **Shipley Fields Road, Frizinghall**  
33 year old female victim walking, sees a group of 3 males, is grabbed by the hood and pulled to the floor, her pockets are searched and property taken. Victim challenges suspects & is punched to the face, she falls to the floor. Victim chases the suspects onto an awaiting bus, altercation ensues between victim & suspects witnessed by members of the public, when police are mentioned the suspects get off the bus & run away. Stolen - £60 cash, mobile. **3 Asian males arrested.**
